## **SECTION 39B BERMUDA LIQUOR LICENSE ACT**

## Section 39B: Training for managers, supervisors and persons in charge of bars

**Subsection (1)** Within twelve months of the coming into operation of this Act, every licensed person shall require every manager, supervisor or person in charge of a bar from which alcohol is provided or sold for consumption on the licensed premises, to be certified as having completed a training programme on responsible alcohol sales and service, prescribed in regulations made under this Act.

**Subsection (2)** A manager, supervisor or a person in charge of a bar from which alcohol is provided or sold for consumption on the licensed premises shall—

- a) while on duty, carry on his person his certificate as evidence that he has been certified as having successfully completed the programme referred to in Subsection (1); and
- b) produce his certificate for inspection at the request of any police officer or other person having reasonable grounds to ask for it.

**Subsection (3)** A licensed person who fails to comply with Subsection (1) or a manager, supervisor or a person in charge of a bar from which alcohol is provided or sold for consumption on the licensed premises who fails to comply with Subsection (2) commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$3,000.
